Sarah Lane Cawte is Education Officer for *Free Churches Group and Churches Together* in England and a resident scholar at the Collegeville Institute.

She is currently a PhD candidate at the University of Exeter (UK). She received her Post-Graduate Diploma in Educational Research from the University of Exeter; her MA in Church Religion and Society 1780-1940 from the Cheltenham and Gloucester College of Higher Education (now University of Gloucestershire); and a Post-Graduate Certificate in Education and a BA in Theology from the University of Durham (UK). She has authored several articles, chapters, and books, many specifically for teachers and students.
